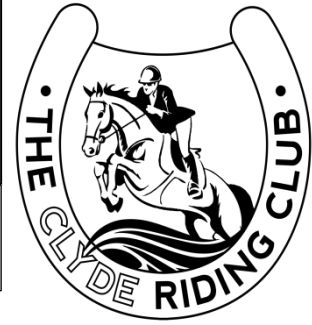


**The Clyde Riding Club
Unaffiliated Show Jumping
West Kype Farm, Strathaven**

Classes are open to full members and day members

We have assigned recommended classes by height of mount (**as outlined below**) for members wishing to accumulate points for end of season perpetual trophies. **Competitors can compete in any class they wish, but points will only be accumulated in the recommended height classes.** Perpetual trophies will be issued at presentation night.

10:00am start

Entry fees: £7.50 for members, £10 for non-members plus £2 day membership and £1 first aid fee (full membership fee £30).

Class 1 Lead Rein (under 8 years old at 31/12/2017) – cross poles only. All double clears win a rosette; all competitors will be allowed to compete in second round regardless of faults in first round.

Class 2 Beginners Novice – cross poles and straights (30-40cm). Genuine novices only. Directional assistance provided by committee members in the first round only.

Class 3 Nursery Novice – max height in first round 50cm (**Clyde minis– under 10 years old at 31/12/2017**)

Class 4 Novice – max height in first round 60cm (**128cm**)

Class 5 Inter-novice– max height in first round 70cm (**138cm**)

Class 6 Intermediate – max height in first round 80cm (**148cm & senior ponies**)

Class 7 Open– max height in first round 90cm (**Horses**)

Class 8 Large Open – max height in first round 1m

SEPARATE AWARDS TO JUNIORS (UNDER 16 AT 31/12/17 ON A PONY) AND SENIORS (INCL. UNDER 16s ON HORSES) IN CLASSES 2-8.

Points for show jumping will be accumulated when a member is placed in any class no lower than one class below the recommended height (**as outlined above**) or any classes higher. There is no restriction on how many classes you can enter, but members will only accumulate points in their first two classes (if eligible). Points will be awarded from 6 to 1 with 6 points going to 1st place, 5 to 2nd place and so on. If non-members are placed the points will go down the line to member riders (will not receive rosette). Please read our handbook for more information on our points system.

Smart show attire required - Must be wearing a hat to BRC 2017 standards - No stallions - Horses must be 4 yrs. old or over - no dogs allowed

HOUSE RULES

- Unattended horses/ponies must not be left tied up outside trailers or horse boxes.
- Horses/ponies may only be tied up to tack/untack.
- No hay or haylage nets may be attached to the outside of trailers or horse boxes at any time.
- All horse droppings must be lifted from the car park and approaches to the arenas (the committee will deal with any in either the main or practice arenas).
- All rubbish must be placed in black bin bags provided.
- Show attire to be worn when competing
- Riding hats must conform to current BRC standards and may be subject to random checks by committee members
- Overuse of the whip will result in a judges' warning and in cases of severe or repeat offences may result in disqualification from competition.
- No horses with red ribbons or a history of kicking to be allowed in the undercover waiting area
- Only horse or pony with rider/groom to be allowed in the undercover area – no spectators allowed.
- If a competitor falls off during their round, they must not remount their horse/pony while in the competition ring.
- Once completing your round please walk straight out of the arena and into the practice arena. To minimise the risk of accidents do not linger outside the entrance/exit of the show ring.
- All competitors and their guests must abide by our rules and by laws at all times. The committee reserve the right to eject any individual who they deem to be behaving inappropriately in any way. See no.19 in our constitution and rules.
